

Dear Visitors,

Welcome to our town, Klatovy, with its reconstructed historical centre and busy streets acting as a gateway to a wealth of natural and cultural attractions and offering something for everyone with a variety of entertainments.

If you would like to get to know more about the history of Klatovy visit the **Ethnographical Museum of Dr. Hostaš**, also housing temporary exhibitions on a variety of themes of local interest. Year-round exhibitions of modern art are on view in the **Klatovy/Klenova Art Gallery**, easily accessible on the main square.

The majestic baroque **Jesuit Church of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary and St. Ignatius**, still fully functioning, tempts you with its richly ornamented facade to investigate further its interior. The two famous architects, **Giovani Domenico Orsi** and **Kilián Ignác Dienzenhofer** were responsible for its design and construction. The **catacombs** elicit feelings of sacred reverence in the secret space below this church. Moments of peace and serenity can be enjoyed in the **Archdeacons Church of the Ascension of the Virgin Mary** situated in one of the little streets just off the main square. For something a little different try the tour around the interesting **Baroque Pharmacy 'At the White Unicorn'** which with its interior and furnishings provides a fascinating glimpse into the reality of life in the 18th century and as such is an acknowledged historical site. For superb views of the town and surrounding countryside the 81m climb up the 226 steps to reach the fifth floor and the viewing platform of the **'Black Tower'** is more than worth the effort. To relax and refresh yourselves afterwards try the tea rooms or cafes or take advantage of the number of good restaurants around the town.

You are also more than welcome to come and enjoy some of the events that shape the identity of our town. Every year in July we hold the traditional **Klatovy Fair** and an accompanying international folklore festival which culminates in performances by local and international artistic



groups. Sporty types, as well as those who enjoy spectating, are bound to enjoy events like the 'BMX Championship', the 'Cyclomathon - Author Kral Sumavy' and the 'Mogul Sumava Rally' - just a few of the highlights on offer in the Klatovy region. For flying enthusiasts and parachutists the Pošumavý Aeroklub of Klatovy offers lots of possibilities. Horse lovers can take advantage of the local facilities and countryside, for example, at 'Calverova Farma' or the 'Western Ranch' at Podoli. For tennis players there are several opportunities on well-maintained facilities. There are also multi-functional sports halls offering all the necessary equipment for everything from body-building to squash, tennis, volleyball and basketball and not least tenpin bowling. Only a few kilometres away, near Nyrsko, is the nearest golf course.

If you like getting out and about and find yourself in Klatovy in winter - no problem. Bring your skates and you can glide away at the Winter Stadium! Or do you like swimming? Then get down to the swimming baths and enjoy as well as the steam room, the weight room or the massage treatments. When the weather is right and the snow has fallen Klatovy is ideal as a place to enjoy cross-country skiing.

Klatovy is an excellent starting point for a variety of excursions. Well-signposted paths and cycling routes suitable for everyone, including families with children, criss-cross the area. Most visitors take a tour around one of the local romantic castles and chateaux, like the moated castle of



Švihov, Velhartice, Rabí or Klenová which in the main summer season also offer programmes of interesting cultural events. Another popular destination is the region around Chudenice and the American Garden, the look-out tower of Bolfánek and the Kvapilovo Lake

We shouldn't forget also to mention some of the very interesting places nearer Klatovy - for climbers the rocks at Tupadelské skaly, and for walkers the woods at Hůrka, Husín and Bor-Smrčín.

Excursions from Klatovy

The Town Gardens (Městské sady)

(ca 2 km, from the main square in the direction of the nearby village of Luby, with the possibility of using local bus no's 1 or 2)

A place for relaxation, particularly suitable for families with children. There is a children's play area with a mini street and traffic area for teaching children the highway code and nearby a little lake, used in winter by skaters. In the summer season refreshments are available in the restaurant, Kolonáda

Křesťanský vrch (návrší "Na Spravedlnosti")

(ca 2 km, from the main square northwards towards Plzeň)

This is a villa quarter, on a wooded hillock to which the street rejoicing in the peculiar name, 'To Justice' (Ke Spravedlnosti) leads - originally it was the site of the town gallows - but now is a favourite local destination. Today there are some tennis courts.

The woodland area Hůrka - the town baths (Lesní komplex Hůrka - Městské lázně)

(ca 4 km, from the main square along the red marked path to Hůrka and to the town baths, from where the green marked path leads back to the bus station)

Hůrka is a much-frequented quiet spot for walks any time of the year. It is a wooded hilltop reaching 498 m asl crowned by the Church of St. Martin, the very visible symbol of Klatovy seen from far away. The view of the countryside around is one of its attractions. The red marked path leads a little further on to the town baths where in the summer people bathe and enjoy the restaurant. A little further on still the path joins the green path which leads us back to the bus station.

The woodland area Bor - Smrčí (Lesní komplex Bor - Smrčí)

ca 5 km in the direction of Svrčovec)

This is the site of the former military shooting range but is now home to the town's commercial forestry with a complementary recreational function. It is also home to an exceptional range of flora and fauna, represented by amongst other things a variety of birdlife. From the whole southern stretch of this area the views of Klatovy are wonderful.

The woodland area Husín (Lesní komplex Husín)

ca 5 km in the direction of Tajanov)

This outdoor area is well-known for its 'mohyly' - prehistoric mounds - as burial places from the middle and late bronze age. About the finds and the site there is not only an information board at the entrance to the woods but also the 'marker stones' of Dr. Hostaš placed throughout the area

On foot and on two wheels

Easy trips

Klatovy - Luby (Spálený les) - Hejno - Klatovy

(cca 10 km, po červené značce, vhodné pro rodiny s dětmi)

Luby - this goes through some suburbs of Klatovy where you can see the Gothic Church of St. Michael with frescoes from the end of the 15th

century. Another little stop would be in "Spálený les" with a memorial to the victims of WWII.

Hejno - a small settlement in the woods and the destination and rest point of the trip. There is the possibility of refreshment in the local pub.

Klatovy - Tajanov - Tupadly - Klatovy

(ca 13 km, along the green marked path from Hůrka or from the bus station, suitable for families with children)

Tupadly - near the village, in the woods are some unique natural landmarks - Tupadelské skaly - the Tupadly rocks (0,40 ha), a in terms of geology and appearance in the landscape these are a very distinct group of projecting silicious schist rocks, beloved by climbers (0,40 ha)

More demanding trips:

Klatovy - Luby - Hejno - Křištín - Střeziměř - Neznašovy - Úliště - Černé Krávy - Horní Lhota - Týnec - Loreta - Luby - Klatovy

(ca 24 km, along the red and yellow marked path, the section from Střeziměř to Neznašovy is not marked, it is necessary to use the main road; between Klatovy and Luby - it is possible to use local transport bus no's 1 or 2; between Neznašovy and Klatovy - it is possible to use train or bus connections)

Klatovy (Hůrka) - Beňovy - Bezděkov - Vítaná - Soustov - Vráž - Struhadlo - Tětětice - Tupadly - Tajanov - Klatovy (ČSAD)

(ca 26 km, along the blue, yellow and green marked paths)

Klatovy - Švihov - Kamýcká skála - Vosí - Vícenická hůrka - Točnick - Klatovy

(ca 28 km, Klatovy - Švihov along the red marked path, possibly using the train or bus connections; Švihov - Točnick along the blue marked path; Točnick - Klatovy along the main road).

Klatovy - Kydliny - Obytce - Barák - Habartice - Plánice - Hnačov - Skránčice - Křižovice - Zdebořice - Hoštice - Hoštičky - Kosmáčov - Lažánky - Sobětice - Luby

(ca 28 km, Klatovy - Plánice along the yellow marked path, possibly using the bus connection; Plánice - Hnačov along the green marked path; then further along the main road to Klatovy)

Klatovy - Nýrsko - Pajrek - Nýrsko - Klatovy

(ca 36 km; Klatovy - Nýrsko - possibly using the train or bus connections; Nýrsko - Pajrek along the green or blue marked path)

Demanding trips:

Klatovy - Komošín (Klatovy - Svrčovec) - Dolany - Malechov - Chlumská - Chudenice - Lučice - Liška (Pušperk) - Poleň - Drslavice - Tajanov - Klatovy

(ca 35 km, Klatovy - Svrčovec it is necessary to use minor roads, Klatovy - Komošín along the red marked path, then along the minor roads to Dolany and Malechov reaching the crossroads above Chlumská - from here along the blue marked path to Chudenice, then along the green marked path to Lučice to the Chudenické pheasantery, to Pušperk, from there along the red marked path to Klatovy)

Klatovy - Měčín - Malinec - Otín - Točnick - Klatovy

(ca 32 km, Klatovy - Měčín possibly using the bus connection; Měčín - Hráz along the blue marked path; Hráz - Otín along the green marked path; then along the main road to Klatovy)

Klatovy - Kdyně - Koráb - Kdyně - Klatovy

(ca 50 km, the hill of Koráb is accessible in a number of ways: by train or bus to Kdyně, from there on foot along the marked path to Koráb; by car along the asphalt road to Koráb; by train to Dobříkov, from there on foot along the yellow marked path to Koráb)

Klatovy - Kdyně - Podzámčí - Ryzmberk - Nový Herštejn - Kdyně - Klatovy

(ca 55 km, by train or bus to Kdyně, from there along the yellow marked path to Ryzmberk, from there along the red marked path to Nový Herštejn)

Trips by bus, car and train

Domažlice (30 km)

The first mention of this settlement is from 971, when it was a customs point. During the 13th century it became a royal town. This picturesque town preserves local customs and traditions (hand-painted ceramics and furniture, traditional dress and a particular form of bagpipe music!). Especially well-known is the 'Chod Festival' which takes place in August, part of which is a traditional fair. Some of the main sights of the town include the Chod Castle (Chodský hrad), the gothic Church of the Birth of the Virgin Mary (including a 56m high circular lookout tower leaning 59 cm from the vertical), a baroque abbey, the gothic Church of All Souls, the fully-preserved gothic Lower Town Gate, arcaded renaissance townhouses, a chapel of St. Vavřinec on a nearby hill (Veselá hora, 2 km), the Museum of the composer Jindřich Jindřich, the Chod Museum and the Gallery Špilárů.

Hartmanice (38 km)

Hartmanice is the oldest village in the High Šumava, when from the year 1209 it served as a customs point on the Vintířova stezka (Vintíř Path). During the Middle Ages it was a centre of gold-mining. Today it is a well-known centre for winter sports. The main sights of the village are the gothic Church of St. Catherine from the 15th century, on a nearby hill, Hamižná hora only 1.5 km away, are remains of mines, signposted with thirteen information points along the way, Dobrá Voda, 2 km away, with the Museum of Dr. Šimon Adler, a Jewish doctor from the 19th century, the Church of St. Vintíř with its unique glass altar and the so-called 'Rock of Vintíř' (Vintířova skála).

Horáždovice (34 km)

This town developed in the second half of the 13th century from an original market town on the banks of the River Otava. Its speciality was the cultivation of oysters for pearls during the 18th century in pools along the river. However, since the second world war the water quality in the river has deteriorated which has had an adverse effect on oyster production. Some of the major sights of the town include the Church of St. Peter and Paul, the abbey Church of the Virgin Mary, the historic sight from the 19th century, 'The Butchers Market' ('Masné krámy'), the Church of St. Jan Křtitel, the Red Gate (one of the oldest surviving town gates in the Czech Republic), the local chateau, which also houses the museum and art gallery, the Jewish cemetery, and the nearby hill, Loreta (0,5 km), and the ruins of the castle at Prácheň (ca 2 km).

Hory Matky Boží (23 km)

A hill village dating back to the beginning of the 16th century which until the 18th century was involved in exploiting the local gold deposits. There is a baroque church from the 17th century and the remains of gold adits and mines nearby reached by signposted paths.

Chanovice (33 km)

The main sights of this village are: the baroque chateau (today home to the local school), the baroque Church of the Holy Cross, a Museum of Traditional Houses, healing springs, lovely views of the Šumava National Park and in nearby Kadov there is a baroque manse, an old-fashioned country hospital and the unique 'Rocking Stone of Kadov'.

Chudenice (15 km)

The village is situated in lovely country below the hill of Žďár (585 m asl.) developed in the 13th century as the family home of the Czernín (Černín) from Chudenice and belonged to this family until 1945. The gothic Church of St. Jan Křtitel, the Chapel of St. Anna, the 'Old Chateau' (Starý zámek) housing the regional museum and an exhibition about the chateau, there is also a Napoleonic chateau called Lázeň (Nový Zámek), today a hotel, and an extensive park encompassing several features of interest - the lookout tower of Bolfánek with the Chapel of St. Wolfgang, the American Garden (Americká zahrada) - a celebrated arboretum established in 1841 and home to 200 types of trees from 3 continents, particularly from North America, dominated by a most stately Douglas fir, and the lovely 'Lake of Kvapilovo'. This park is thanks to its unique origin well preserved to an extent of 12 ha and much appreciated as one of the most precious areas in this part of Bohemia.

Kašperské Hory (33 km)

A much sought after tourist destination situated in the mountain region on the southern slopes above the River Opilecky and the River Otava, mentioned at the turn of the 13th century as a centre of gold mining. The area around this town contains some of the most important and valuable natural habitats in the Šumava National Park and as such is a protected area. Some of the sights of the town are the Town Hall, the Church of St. Michael, the pilgrimage Church of the Virgin Mary of the Snows, the Church of St. Marketa, the Šumava Museum, a Museum of Historic Motorcycles, the circular signposted path highlighting the gold-mining activities near the town (Cestou zlatokopů), the castle of Kašperk (3 km), and finally a herd of bison at nearby Červená.

Koloveč (22 km)

This village is first mentioned in the 12th century and from the 17th century becomes well-known for its pottery. Sights include the site of the Chod pottery production with distinctive local decoration, the baroque Church of The Annunciation of the Virgin Mary, whose oratory is connected to the manse by an arcaded rococo bridge, and there is also a Museum of Technology and Craftsmanship

Koráb (20 km)

This hill, at 772 m, is the highest point of the chain known as the Chudenické Hills (Chudenické vrchoviny) is crowned by a hut and a modern lookout tower erected between 1990 - 1992 on the site of the original building from 1938. This unique tower is in the shape of a cylinder, whose interior houses a staircase of 144 steps to a viewing platform at a height of 30 m. An asphalt road leads to the tower and the hut.

Nalžovské Hory (22 km)

In the Middle Ages this was an area exploiting silver, tin and lead deposits continuing until 1898. The chateau is from the 17th century and the point of interest is the wood and park at nearby Prašivice, which contains stone statues shaped into the forms of animals from around 1840

Nýrsko (16 km)

Already by the end of the 19th century this town was famous for the production of optical lenses (W. Eckstein a spol.) which continues to the present under the name of Okula. Nýrsko is the starting point for a marked path with 19 information boards and is a very well-touristed route for visitors

travelling through the foothills of the Šumava. Sights include the Church of St. Thomas, the baroque manse, historic houses on the main square, the ruins of Pajrek (ca 3 km) a castle guarding the nearby border with Bavaria, the former Woodland Theatre (Lesní divadlo), a Jewish cemetery from the 15th century and above the outdoor theatre there is a skiing slope with artificial surface and a drag lift.

Rýzmbek (27 km)

Here are the remains of a castle founded in the second half of the 13th century. Also remains of a lookout tower and a castle theatre where there is an annual event - 'The Rýzmberský Castle Goulash' - a festival of folk and country music. During the summer months there is a little pub open in the third castle courtyard.

Sušice (30 km)

Originally a gold-panning settlement first mentioned in the 13th century and by the middle of the 19th century famous for the production of phosphorous matches, still manufactured today under the name of Solo. This economic and cultural centre is well-visited by tourists.

Sights include the Town Hall, historic houses (Voprchovský, Rozacínovský, Krocínovský), the Church of St. Václav, the Capuchin Abbey with its Church of St. Felix, the Museum of the Šumava, the Gallery 'Skla', the 32 m high lookout tower Svatobor, the Chapel of the Guardian Angel at 562 m asl, the water basin from 1901, a Jewish cemetery and the nearby hill called Žižkův vrch, named after the famous Hussite leader and crowned by their symbol

Železná Ruda (39 km)

Originally a mountain settlement founded in the 16th century. It flourished mainly because of the iron ore mines which lasted roughly 150 years and left the village the legacy of the name. A further significant stage of the development of Železná Ruda occurred at the beginning of the 17th century thanks to the rich deposits of silica and limestone and led to the glass-making industry and the establishment of factories which lasted until the 19th century. Železná Ruda is an important tourist centre with facilities for summer or winter stays.

Sights include the baroque Church of the Virgin Mary (Pomocné z Hvězdy), the Chapel of St. Anthony and St. Barbara, the Chapel of St. Anna, an iron mill from the end of the 18th century on the banks of the Řezná still in use until 1947, the Museum of the Šumava, the Black Lake (Černé jezero, 4 km), the Devil's Lake (Čertovo jezero, 6 km), and the waterfall Bílá strž (9 km)

Žinkovy (18 km)

A summer tourist destination with a large lake.

Sights include the pseudo-renaissance chateau (not open to the public), the Church of St. Václav, a museum, the archaeological site, Obrovo hradiště, containing remains of a settlement from the period of early Slav settlement and the ruins of the castle Potštejn (1 km).

The Old Chateau, Chudenice

The place is mentioned in the 13th century as the seat of the important Czech family, the Černín family (Černín). The Old Chateau on the square was originally a fortified tower remodelled in the 16th century renaissance style and later still in the 18th century into the baroque style. Not faraway is the arboretum called the American Garden (Americká zahrada) which is one of the oldest gardens of its kind in Europe offering walks amongst trees from all over the world. In the garden is the Napoleonic-style Chateau called Lázeň.

Point of interest - The so-called 'Andělský pokoj' the 'Room of the Angel' and a 'black kitchen' (černá kuchyně). About the 'Room of the Angel' it is said that in it in 1601 an angel revealed itself to Humprecht Černín, which announced his imminent death within three days. About the 'black kitchen' it is said that the name Černín came from the fact that the only surviving member of the family emerged from this room, like a miracle. (Černín is connected with the word 'black')

Kašperk Castle was built as a stronghold by Charles IV in 1356 who assigned the building of the castle to his Master Builder, Vítek, known as Hedvabný (the Silky One!) The foundation of this enormous building was already completed by 1361. This royal castle is the highest castle in Bohemia at 886m asl and its present name is a corruption of the German form of the original Czech name - Karlsberg from Karlova hora.

Point of interest - the castle offers wonderful views of central Šumava and the region around. In the vicinity are a number of marked and circular paths

These are the ruins of one of the oldest castles in Bohemia, first mentioned in 1287. The romantic chateau was intended to be one of the first examples of the Novo-Gothic

style when it was built in the 1830's. The castle ruins have been used as a romantic backdrop in films and also as a viewing point. On the first floor of the chateau is a permanent exhibition of historic interiors as well as a space for 20th century Czech art (a fundamental part of this exhibition is dedicated to the work of Vilma Vrbová-Kotrbová). In the grounds of the castle are some fine sculptures. It is possible to move freely around the castle without a guide.

Rabí Castle, founded apparently already by the 13th century is now as the most widespread castle ruin in Bohemia. The unfinished castle fortifications are amongst the most advanced in Europe

Point of interest - in the year 1420 the castle was besieged by the Hussite leader, Jan Žižkov, and in 1421, at the second siege, the unfortunate general lost his second eye

A late gothic moated castle in the meadows edging the River Úhlava north of Klatovy founded in 1480 by Půta Švihovský, at that time one of the richest and most influential men in Bohemia. The first part of the castle

was finished in 1489 but the rest not finished until 1510. In the 18th century the castle was rebuilt as a grain store and in the second half of the 20th century the castle was restored and opened to the public.

Point of interest - a castle with a protective water system which was counted amongst the best fortresses of its period

A Mediaeval gothic castle from the beginning of the 14th century situated amongst beautiful wooded hills on the slopes above the River Ostružna. The 32m long, four-arched, stone bridge on cylindrical pillars connecting the castle Palace, the so-called 'Rajský dům', to the opposite tower, called 'Putna', is quite unique

Point of Interest - near the castle is a collection of traditional houses and wooden cabins from the Klatovy region and from around Sušice

Shopping

Usual opening times: Monday to Friday from 9 am to 5 pm, Saturdays 9 am to 12 am. There are several supermarkets in Klatovy: Hypernova, Kaufland, Plus, Lidl, Penny which stay open over the weekend. Every Monday there is an open market in the square.

Cash points

Each bank has a cash point which is available 24 hrs a day. Three banks are located on the square, Komerční Banka, Obchodní Banka and Spořitelna.

Transport

There are two railway lines crossing the town, no. 183 Plzeň-Klatovy-Železná Ruda and no. 185 Horažďovice-Klatovy-Domažlice.

Klatovy region can be easily accessed by bus. The bus station can be found on Hlávkova ulice, a five-minute walk from the railway station.

The municipal public transport lines no. 1, 2 and 4 will get you to the bus and railway stations.

Free time: Swimming, Skateboarding and Skating

If you fancy a change from shopping and sightseeing, you might like to go for a swim either to the indoor swimming pool or to the open-air swimming baths. Both can be found in Dr Sedláka ulice. Children might also enjoy the newly built playground with skateboarding facilities (U Čedíku) or the BMX complex (Plánická ulice). Ice skating is available in winter at the ice stadium in Nerudova ulice

Cycling Routes

There are several cycling routes going through the region, for example no. 332 going to Železná Ruda, no. 2080 to Plánice, no. 38 to Švihov, 2052 to Janovice n/Úhlavou. There are two cycling paths in Klatovy, one in Dr Sedláka ulice and the other one, leading to Vrhavěč, in Sadová ulice. Cycling paths are also used by roller skating enthusiasts.

Marked walking paths can also be used by cyclists. Several signposts can be found around the town, for example at the bus station or by the football pitch in Luby.
